Directions To The Trial Site

Cloud Nine Training & Event Center 11528 96th Ave N Maple Grove, MN 55369

From 610: Take Zachary Lane and head South. Turn Right onto 95th Ave N to 96th Ave N. Follow the road to the end of the buildings. Cloud Nine is the last Building closest to 610.

Note: GPS often takes people to the Park and Ride lot when coming from the east side of town (169/610). To avoid that, once on Zachary Lane go west on 95th Ave. N (not 96th Ave N). Go west on 95th Ave. N to 96th Ave. N (just before the school bus company) and turn right. Follow the road as it turns east to the end of the row of buildings. Cloud Nine is in the last building at the end closest to Hwy 610.

Information For Exhibitors

<u>Food</u>: Food is available for workers only at these trials. There are several restaurants around the show site.

<u>Obstacles</u>: Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

<u>Warm-Ups</u>: A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

<u>Ringside</u>: Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

<u>Dogs Eligible to Enter</u>: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or register able breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

<u>Height Divisions</u>: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. <u>Regular Titling Classes</u>:

8 Inches—For Dogs 11 Inches and under at the withers.

12Inches—For Dogs 14 Inches and under at the withers.

16 Inches—For Dogs 18 Inches and under at the withers.

20 Inches—For Dogs 22 Inches and under at the withers.

24 Inches—For Dogs over 22 Inches at the withers.

24C —May Be Entered at Owner's discretion.

Preferred Titling Classes:

4 Inches—For Dogs 11 Inches and under at the withers.

8 Inches—For Dogs 14 Inches and under at the withers.

12Inches—For Dogs 18 Inches and under at the withers.

16 Inches—For Dogs 22 Inches and under at the withers.

20 Inches—For Dogs over 22 Inches at the withers.

Information For Exhibitors Cont.

<u>Prize and Awards</u>: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard and Jumpers with Weaves class. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score. A MACH/PACH bar and Rosette will be awarded to each team earning MACH/PACH. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be clamed at the show as none will be mailed.

Refunds: Entry fees for bitches that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded with a veterinary note presented to the trial secretary (minus \$15.00 administration fee per day). Request for refunds must be made prior to the start of judging. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

<u>Safety/Behavior</u>: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rule and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are fee of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when using the warm-up jump.

<u>Liability</u>: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitors whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. BOTC and its agents, employees, ect. will not assume responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

<u>Crating</u>: No Ex-pens allowed. Crates may be left overnight; however BOTC and Cloud Nine will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Entry Fees: Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on US accounts or with international money orders payable in US funds.

Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
