Entry fees shall not be refunded for the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of the entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and, in the event, it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of the entry fee will be made.
- POST DATED CHECKS OR RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.
- ALL PRIZES must be claimed at the show...if not, they become the property of the Show Giving Club.
- NO PRIZES will be mailed.
- BLOOMINGTON OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT to substitute prizes with ones
  of equal or greater value.
- THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS as set forth on the Official AKC Entry form for these events.
