EXHIBITORS.....Please Note

- **TO HELP AVOID ERRORS IN THE CATALOG** Please typewrite or print clearly all information on your entry form. Include your zip code in your mailing address. Send the signature page of the entry form. Entries cannot be accepted without a signature.
- **NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- **UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.** Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Judging program and numbers will be emailed to the exhibitors. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- **NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.** Entry fees shall not be refunded for the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and, in the event, it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- **POST DATED CHECKS or RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- **JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

ROUTES TO BLOOMINGTON OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB

From the East: Go west on 494 to Lyndale Avenue Exit. Left (south) on Lyndale to 82nd Street. Left (east) on 82nd Street to Pleasant Ave. Left on Pleasant Avenue to 8127 Pleasant Avenue South.

From the West: Go east on 494 to Lyndale Avenue Exit. Left (south) on Lyndale to 82nd Street. Left (east) on 82nd Street to Pleasant Ave. Left on Pleasant Avenue to 8127 Pleasant Avenue South.

From the North: South on 35W to 82nd Ave Exit (just south of the 494 & 35W interchange), Left (east) on 82nd Street to Pleasant Ave. Left on Pleasant Avenue to 8127 Pleasant Avenue South.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
